

PER-CALL BLOCKING

Block your number from being displayed to others.

How it works:

By dialing a code before you place a call, you can prevent your name and/or phone number from appearing on the Caller ID display of the person receiving your call.

How to use:



1. Lift the handset and listen for the dial tone.

2. Press *67.



3. Dial the number you're calling as usual.

4. The person you've called will not be able to see your number displayed on their telephone display screen. Instead, "Private" or "Anonymous" will be displayed.

Notes:

- You must dial *67 before each call you place, otherwise, your name and/or phone number will be released to the person receiving your call.
- If you have requested Per-Line Blocking from us, you do not need to dial a code to block your number before each call. Your number will always appear as "Private." To override Per-Line Blocking (allowing your number to be displayed) on an individual call, dial *82 before placing the call.
